Associate in Applied Science: Computer Information Systems Specialization, Business Administration 2+2 with West Liberty University: Looking Ahead

- The "2+2" term is used to refer to a transfer agreement through which a student completes an Associate degree at WVNC and finishes a Bachelor degree at a transfer institution-- in this case, West Liberty University. Because of individual student factors, part-time or full-time status, need for developmental education coursework, wcheduling and availability of courses, or other factors, all students may not be able to complete this program in the collective 4 years (two for an Associate's and two additional for a Bachelor's). The term "2+2" does not imply a guarantee that a student will be able to complete all requirements in 4 years.

Preparing for West Liberty University

- Always consult your advisor at both WVNC and WLU early into your program to check which additional requirements, if any, exist for admission into the Computer Information Systems Specialization: Business Administration baccalaureate program.
- Upon graduation from WVNC, don't forget to request your academic transcript be sent to WLU's registrar's office and complete a transfer clearance form.
