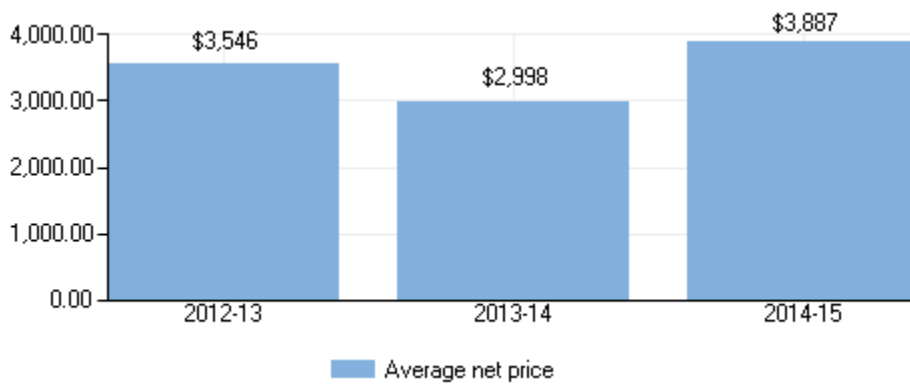

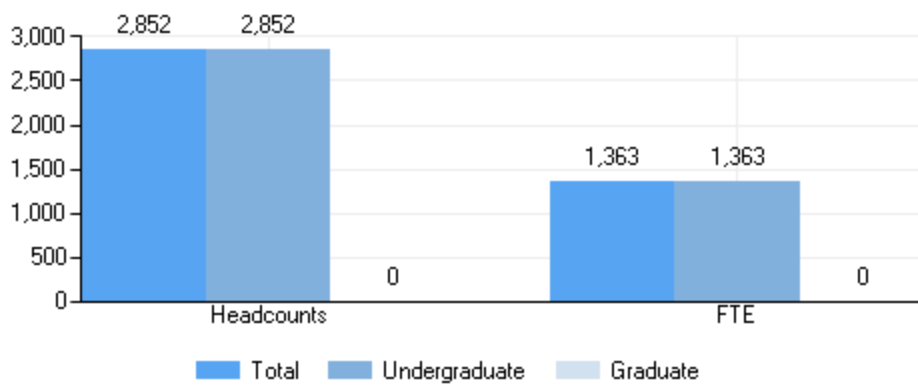

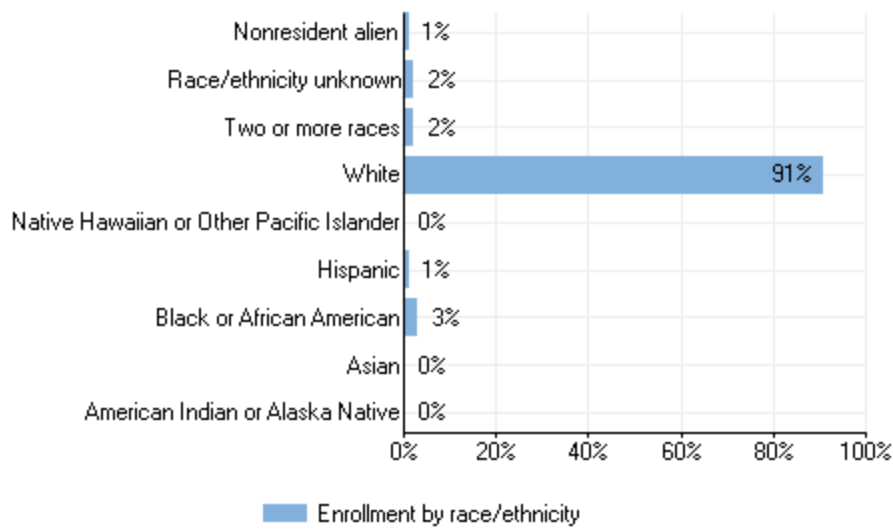
Enrollment**Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2014-15**



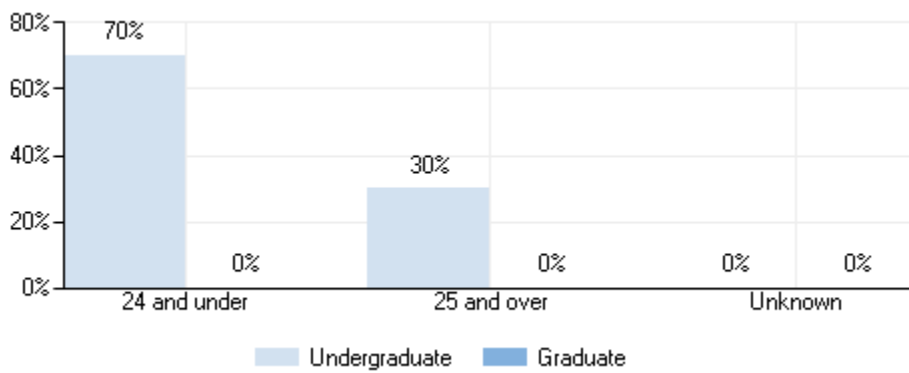

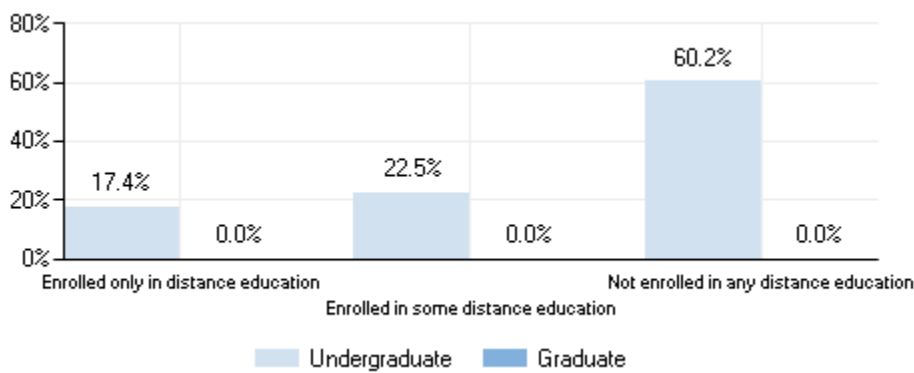
Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2015



Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2015

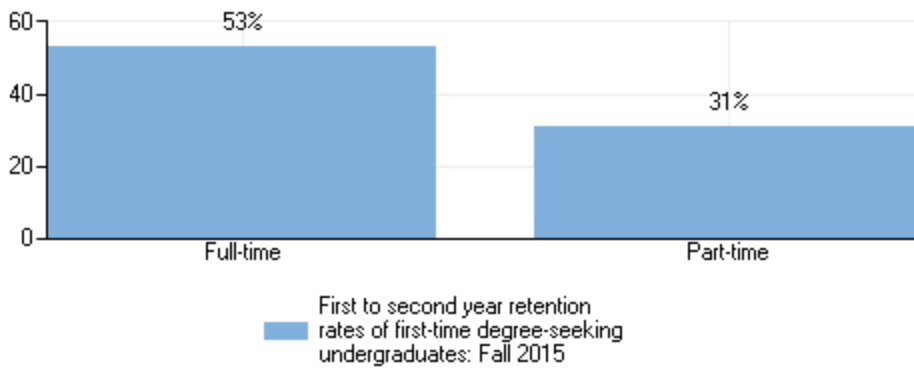


Enrollment by distance education: Fall 2015

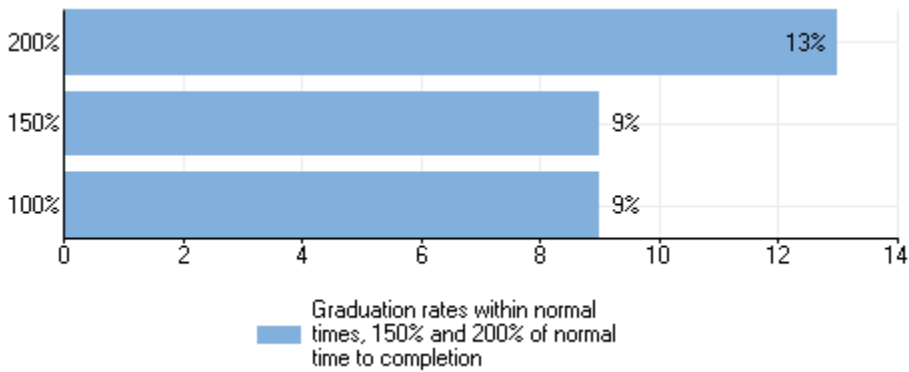

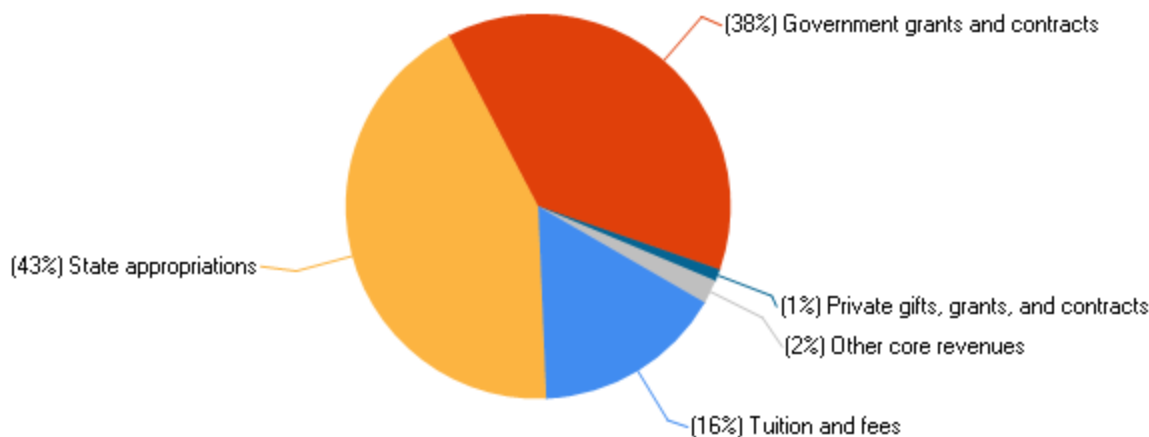

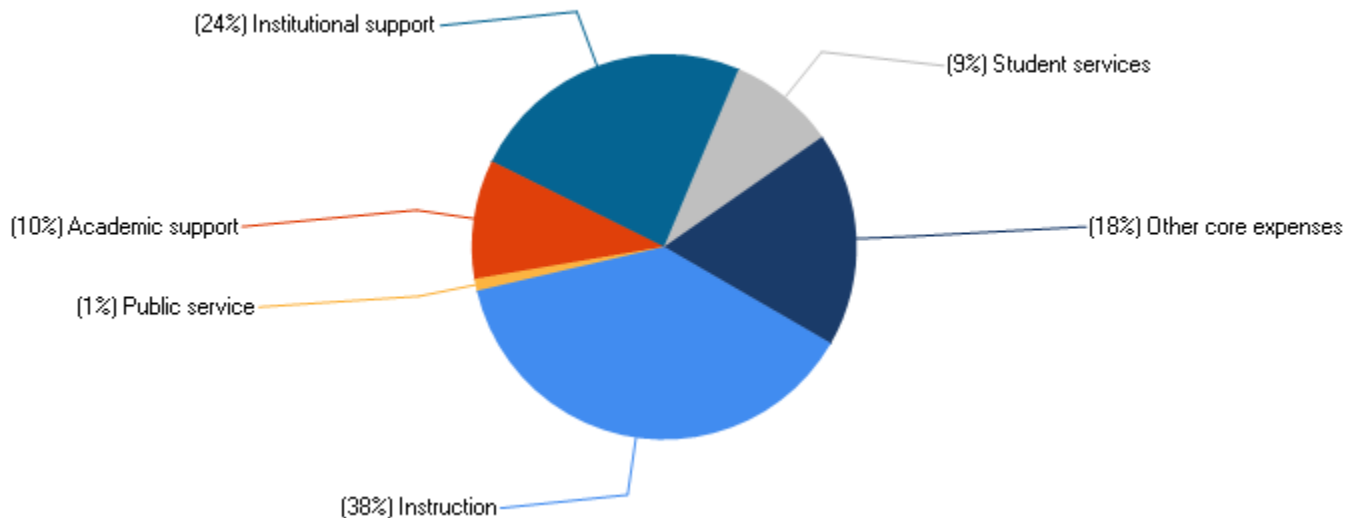
Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2015
