TEAS INFORMATION

The Nursing program requires a minimum score on the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) for admission purposes.

Register for the TEAS at <u>www.atitesting.com</u>. TEAS scores must be within the last three (3) years from Nursing application date. Pre-nursing admission exam may be completed a maximum of two (2) times in one year for consideration for admission. Applicant may be considered again after one (1) year.

Find TEAS prep information on the ATI website, through the BrainFuse online tutoring option in the Student Portal, or through other online and print resources available through web-searches, the college library, or the Academic Support Center.

IMPORTANT: TEAS scores must be saved in the proper format and submitted to the Admissions Office by email, regardless of where the test was administered. Applicants should save and submit the scores themselves rather than having scores sent to the college by ATI.

After finishing the exam:

- 1. Log into www.atitesting.com.
- 2. Select the My Results tab.
- 3. Click the name of the test under "Assessment Name."
- 4. Click Download Report from the upper right of the screen to access the Individual Performance Profile.
- 5. Save the digital file and email it to wvnccadmissions@wvncc.edu.

If you have taken the TEAS more than once, submit Individual Performance Profiles from each attempt.

Applicants who sign up to take the TEAS on WVNCC's campus must review the <u>TEAS Testing Room</u> Procedure and bring a signed copy when they report to test.
