# **CFOV SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES FOR ENROLLED COLLEGE STUDENTS**

#### The Warren, Mary & Debbie Bennett Scholarship **Eligibility:**

- Must be a graduating high school senior or enrolled college student from the tri-state area with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Must plan to attend a two-year or four-year college, trade school or certificate program
- Preference will be given to applicants who are current, baptized members of a Church of Christ located in the tri-state area •
- For the purposes of this scholarship, tri-state area is defined as areas of West Virginia, Ohio and Pennsylvania generally considered to be located within a reasonable distance from Weirton, WV

#### **AAUW Beulah Boyd Scholarship**

#### **Eligibility:**

- Applicant must have completed 30 credit hours of college courses, with a minimum GPA of 2.2
- Must reside in Brooke, Ohio, or Marshall counties in West Virginia or Belmont County, Ohio •
- Application timeline will be posted within this listing on the CFOV website

# John & Norma Miller-Daffin Educators' Scholarship

**Eligibility:** 

- Applicant must be a college junior or senior who graduated from Bridgeport High School or a Belmont County, Ohio high school
- Must be majoring in Early Childhood or Elementary Education
- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA

### **Richard Heagin Memorial Scholarship**

**Eligibility:** 

- For residents of Belmont, Jefferson, Harrison, Guernsey, Noble, or Monroe Counties in Ohio •
- Must plan to pursue a field of study that results in a paramedic or firefighter certification

# Joseph M. & Annale R. Wells Scholarship

**Eligibility:** 

- Applicant must be a graduate of a Wetzel County High School and/or a resident of Wetzel County, West Virginia •
- Applicant must be or plan to be a full-time student attending any accredited college or university who is pursuing an associate degree, bachelor's degree, or postgraduate degree
- All fields of study will be considered •
- Must demonstrate a high level of academic achievement, 3.0 or higher GPA on a 4.0 scale, evidence of leadership in the • community, and evidence of service to others in the community

## **David Robertson Scholarship**

**Eligibility:** 

- Applicant must reside in a county served by CFOV •
- Applicant must be pursuing/plan to pursue an associate degree at any WVNCC campus and be enrolled next academic year
- HS senior applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 to apply; current WVNCC students must have a cumulative 2.5 •
