STUDENT ID CARDS FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING CLASS ON CAMPUS

All College building doors, with the exception of the main entrance doors to the Weirton, New Martinsville, and Wheeling (B&O Building) campuses, are locked at all times and must be accessed with a student ID card. You can pick up your Student ID card from the Service Center. **ID cards will not be activated until the first day of your classes.**

PARKING PASSES (WHEELING CAMPUS ONLY)

Parking tags are required for fall and spring semesters. You can complete the [Parking Permit Application](#). There is no fee for your tag. Parking maps are available at the Wheeling Service Center or [online](#).
