Purpose:

To comply with state code and the HEPC regarding credit card companies on campus.

Rule:

WV Code 18B-14-10 states governing boards of each institution shall propose rules in accordance with the rule adopted by the Higher Education Policy Commission pursuant to the provisions of section six, article one of this chapter no later than July 1, 2003, to regulate the marketing practices used on campuses by credit card companies.

Solicitation for commercial purposes for all services, including credit cards, is prohibited in all college buildings and on all college grounds. Solicitation for commercial purposes means selling or marketing items on campus by private businesses or individuals for purposes of making a profit.

Exempt from this rule is the College bookstore, businesses or individuals that provide goods or services which are necessary for the College's operation, and businesses or individuals who sell goods or services to students which are necessary for the program of study. In all cases, no entity may solicit credit cards to students on campus.
