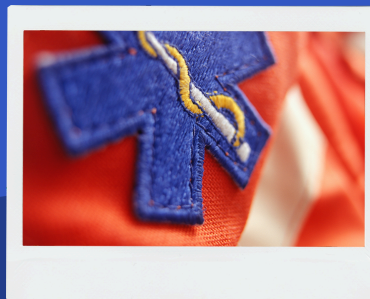
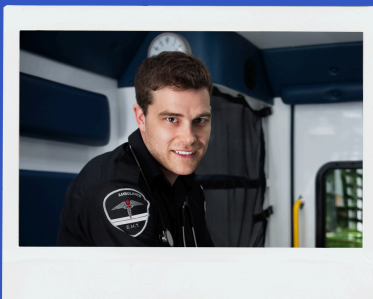
WHO CAN APPLY?

Applicants must:

- * 18 years or older
- * Be authorized to work in the United States
- * Meet eligibility requirements for paramedic certification in WV
- * Commit to working in WV for one year after completing the program
