Dr. Mosser	Welcome back message
	COVID Update – The taskforce sent out an update including no masks, and no vaccine mandate. You may see exceptions to the rule. Add wearing masks to the syllabus. IF you have special health concerns for yourself and need to do more than the college, you are free to add that to your syllabus. Cases are relatively low to moderate. If it goes to red we will likely add restrictions.
	HLC Accreditation – this is the start of a new 10-year cycle. The evidence document is due in November. Dr. Mosser is asking faculty to read the document. Expecting a site visit December 5 th and 6 th . Many of us will be interviewed. They are looking to see the on-site response matches the evidence document. Mosser asks faculty to focus on the 5 criteria. Without accreditation we will not receive Pell Grants and it affects our ability to remain open.
	Student Success Initiatives –
	Action Center – developed as a way to elevate student advising, career placement and transfers. Title III - has four areas that all overlap student success and tie into the ACTion center. Rural Guided Pathways – a three-year effort – We will implement best practices for retention and student completion.
	Fall enrollment is up and it has been up as high as 30%, and it currently running 8% increase from last year.

	The 5-year Education Plan which is being finalized right now.
Dr. Loveless	Several faculty members are starting their OER courses this fall and the state has offered another year of OER grants, WVNCC will match the amount of the grant totaling \$2,000.
	The nursing simulation lab will be opened later this fall.
