

Authorized Use of Alcoholic Beverages on the Campuses

This administrative procedure establishes the guidelines relating to the possession or use of alcoholic beverages on the campuses. It is not the purpose of this administrative procedure to promote or condone the possession or use of beer, wine or other alcoholic beverages on or in the College property or facilities but to regulate such possession or use within the strict guidelines of authorized use.

The possession or use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited on or in property or facilities of the College except as provided below:

- 1. Where the serving of wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages is approved by the College president or his/her designee, on a case by case basis consistent with the following:
 - a. Wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages will never be the primary reason for the gathering.
 - b. The preponderance of those attending must be of legal drinking age.
 - c. No person under the legal drinking age will be served.
 - d. Alternative non-alcoholic beverages and food will be served.
 - e. No person under the age of eighteen (18) will be allowed to serve wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages, and servers must be appropriately trained to adhere to all laws and regulations regarding the serving of wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages.
 - f. No state funds will be used to purchase wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages.
- 2. Where the Culinary Arts program use or serving of wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages is permitted in culinary arts classes for educational purposes and is also permitted to be served during culinary arts luncheons and dinners.

The selling of beer, wine, or other alcoholic beverages to the general public by the College is prohibited unless approved by the College President.
