The Fall 2022 admission will be chosen based upon the total number of points from the above selection criteria. Those students scoring higher on the selection criteria will be chosen before students with lower selection points. In the event of a tie in selection points, the highest grade GPA will be the first tie breaker and then the highest score on the TEAS test. If a student is not selected for a Fall admission into the program, they must reapply for the following year.

Priority Deadline: For priority consideration you must have a minimum of 12 selection points. Those submitting by March 1st who are under 12 points will be reviewed at the final deadline of May 19th.
