Those students scoring higher on the selection criteria will be chosen before students with lower selection points. In the event of a tie in selection points, the highest grade GPA will be the first tie breaker and then the highest score on the TEAS test. If a student is not selected for a Fall admission into the program, they must reapply for the following year.

Priority Deadline: For priority consideration you must have a minimum of 12 selection points. Those submitting by March 1st who are under 12 points will be reviewed at the final deadline of May 19th.
