

PROVISIONAL SELECTION PROCESS

The Nursing application is available online on the Nursing program webpage and requires a \$25 non-refundable application fee. Incomplete applications will NOT be submitted to the Nursing Department for review until all requirements are submitted to the college and verified by the Admissions Office.

Applicants should check their WVNCC email accounts regularly for updates from the Admissions Office on the status of their application.

A completed application includes the following:

1. Official US high school transcript or GED/TASC scores on file with the college. Graduates of non-US high schools must submit GED/TASC scores.
2. Official college transcripts from all schools attended on file with the college. Transcripts should arrive sufficiently prior to the deadline to allow at least 5 business days for processing.
3. Minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.5. If no college GPA is established, high school GPA within 3 years will be used.
4. College credit or placement test scores (ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer) showing eligibility for college-level English and Math without supplement.
5. Individual Performance Profile showing a minimum composite TEAS score of 58. See [TEAS Information page](#) for instructions for registering for the TEAS and obtaining scores in the proper format.

Please note that for consideration toward the Nursing program selection points or graduation requirements, Anatomy and Physiology courses (I and II) must have been completed no longer than 3 years prior to admission. ie: for Fall 2021 = A&P 2 must have been completed no longer ago than Spring 2018. A&P courses completed prior to that time must be repeated

Students who apply by March 1, 2021 will receive priority consideration. **Early application is highly recommended.** NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MAY 20TH, 2021.

Applications will be reviewed and provisional acceptance or declination letters will be mailed within one month of priority evaluation (March 1). Applications (new and those not accepted by the priority deadline) will be reviewed a final time after May deadline.

Students accepted to the program will receive mailed information on confirming their spot in the program, attending program orientation, and completing required steps such as background checks, drug screenings, and physical examinations. Applicants must be prepared to pay a non-refundable \$200 deposit to confirm their spot upon acceptance.

If a student is declined, an explanation will be provided.
