SUMMER 2026 CALENDAR

Early registration* Begins at 9 am Mon., Nov. 17, 2025
Textbook vouchers available (for financial aid students) Mon., May 11
Last day to pay for early registration Thur., May 14
Payments due by noon.

Registration Ends Fri., May 15 at 12 noon
(Only applies to classes that begin the week of May 19.)

Summer term begins Tues., May 19

Memorial Day Holiday - College closed Mon., May 25

Independence Day Holiday - College closed Fri., July 3

Courses can begin at any time during the Summer Term and can vary in length from one-12 weeks. Twelve-week courses begin May 19.

* New and returning students who need to complete the placement testing should see a Service Center representative.
Students registering after May 15, must either pay in full, pay 25% of your total tuition and fees with an installment agreement or have your financial aid file complete to hold your registration.

SUMMER COURSE DATES AND WITHDRAW/DROP DATE INFORMATION

Courses can begin (and end) at any time during the Summer Term and can vary in length from one-12 weeks. Most courses fit the following schedule:

FULL SUMMER TERM COURSES May 19 – August 7

Last day to Withdraw/Drop course July 31

FIRST HALF SUMMER COURSES May 19 – June 28

Last day to Withdraw/Drop course June 12

SECOND HALF SUMMER COURSES June 29 – August 7

Last day to Withdraw/Drop course July 31

TUITION REFUND POLICY

Only in cases where the College cancels class or a student withdraws by the Sunday evening at midnight within the add/drop week of the semester or prior to the class starts for those classes with a delayed start, will full tuition and course fee(s) be refunded. Students who totally withdraw from all of their classes will have their tuition adjusted according to the following schedule:

Prior to the first day of the semester 100% refund

During the first week or 10% of the term 90% refund

Students completing 11%-25% of the term 75% refund

Students completing 26%-38% of the term 50% refund

Students completing 39% or more of the term No refund
