### **ARRT CREDENTIALING EXAMINATION PASS RATE:**

\*The 5-year average for the credentialing exam pass rate is 75% on the first attempt within 6 months of graduation.

### **JOB PLACEMENT RATE:**

- The 5-year average for the job placement rate is 75% for those graduates who actively sought employment within one year of graduation. “Job Placement Rate” (per JRCERT) does not include (1) graduates who fail to communicate with program officials regarding employment status, OR (2) graduates who are unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, OR (3) graduates who are unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, OR (4) graduates on active military duty, OR (5) graduate pursuing continuing education.

- The 5-year average for the program completion rate is 75% within 150% of start date.
