

Medical Assisting Program Admission Requirements

PROGRAM ADMISSION INFORMATION:

Admission to the Clinical Medical Assisting, AAS program requires (1) completion of a Allied Health Application; (2) Overall GPA of 2.25 at the time of admission; (3) successful completion of a background check and drug screening; (4) successful completion of the Administrative Medical Assisting, CAS program.

Students who apply by March 26, 2020 will receive priority consideration. The final deadline is June 11, 2020. [UPDATE 3/27/2020 - Due to the disruptions caused by COVID-19, the final deadline has been extended to June 30, 2020.]

Please print and submit the required Allied Health Application for Clinical Medical Assistant, A.A.S. then **check your WVNCC email account regularly** for updates from the Admissions Office.

A minimum grade of a "C" is required in all courses to remain in the program and graduate.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION:

Students applying for admission to the Clinical Medical Assisting, AAS program will be required to complete the following:

1. A physical examination as per the Allied Health Department Health Record. (Students schedule with their own physicians)
2. Uniforms, sphygmomanometer, and stethoscope are required and can be purchased through the College bookstore using financial aid funds. Students will also be required to purchase shoes and a watch as described in program orientation.
