Purpose:

WV Code 18B-10-1 states that each governing board shall

- 1. Fix tuition and other fees for each academic term for the different classes or categories of students enrolling at the state institution of higher education under its jurisdiction:
- 2. Record tuition and fees in the minutes of the Board meeting and file with the CTCS
- 3. Require all fees due no later than the end of the term and provide measures for collecting past due fees
- 4. Provide students the ability to arrange;
 - a. Installment plans
 - b. Payment by credit cards and other methods
- 5. Address
 - a. Providing a basis for establishing nonresident tuition & fees;
 - b. Allowing governing boards to charge different tuition and fees for different programs;
 - c. Authorizing a governing board to propose to the commission, a mandatory auxiliary fee;
 - d. Ensuring tuition and fees is comparable with peer institutions.

Rule:

The Board of Governors authorizes College personnel to create polices and procedures to comply with WV Code 18B-10-1 concerning the establishment of tuition and fees, the appropriate approvals, and record keeping.
