- Update from Tami positive feedback from last webinar included testimonials from faculty, and students.
- Another institution testimony showed a 15% buy in at the beginning and then by 3rd semester they were at 50-60% of students using it by the end of the trial.
- Students felt connected due to the study aspect and connection abilities during the lockdown.
- This may serve our first-year students as well.
- Cheating concerns were addressed everything is monitored, and students cannot log in without revealing their identity which lowers the instance of cheating.
- The deadline to join is March 31st.
- Cost calculations: \$3,500 for five months (8/1 to 12/31) \$8,400 a year.
- Can use CARES funds for cost.
