- High school transcript, GED™, TASC or HiSET scores. NOTE: Applicants who graduated from high school or passed their GED™, TASC, or HiSET more than five (5) years prior to admission and/or have earned 30 or more semester hours of credit at a regionally accredited institution are exempt from this requirement.
- Official transcripts from all postsecondary educational institutions previously attended, sent directly from the Registrar's Office of the previous institution(s)
