

Currently there are several ways families and students can get assistance virtually. The following methods below are all available with qualified financial aid representatives with the Higher Ed Policy Commission, Federal Student Aid, or WV Northern Financial Aid Staff.

- 1) WV's 2020-21 Statewide Financial Aid Workshop Series Schedule: https://content.xap.com/media/39551/wv 2020-21 statewide financial aid workshop series schedule.pdf
- 2) FALL 2021 Students: File your 2021-2022 FAFSA online at www.FAFSA.gov. You will use your 2019 tax information (taxes filed in 2020). If you are a WV resident, complete the FAFSA by April 15th, 2021 to meet the WV Higher Education Grant Deadline.

- 3) If you have questions concerning your FAFSA or Federal Student Aid programs, but your school's financial aid office is closed or limiting visitors, call 1-800-4FED-AID or access 24/7 online help at: https://studentaid.gov/help-center/contact.
- 4) The College Foundation of West Virginia also has an online 24/7 chat help that can answer basic questions regarding federal and state aid. - 5) Use your time at home wisely. NOW is a great time to apply for scholarships! CFWV is a great place to start.
